

## In memory of Gareth Dunn

On Sunday 17th May 2026, the seventh annual Cookridge Community 10K and Fun Run will take place around Golden Acre Park.

The races support Cancer Research UK and local charities and the run is dedicated to local fundraiser, Gareth Dunn, who sadly passed away from cancer in 2018 aged just 27 after raising over £100,000 for Cancer Research UK.

Last year's run was a 'sell out' with over 500 runners and this year even more runners are expected to take part on what is one of the most scenic trail runs in the North of England.

As a local, community-based event, we are asking for support from local companies and businesses in order to cover the running costs of the event, so all other funds raised go directly to charity.
